Entries taken – Tuesday, August 22nd
9:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m.

Contest Rules

1. There will be no pre-registration and there will be no prize money. Ribbons will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners. Ribbons may be picked up at the tent following judging on Tuesday, August 22nd until 5:00 p.m. or on Sunday, August 27th when the Fair closes.
2. All entries are to be registered and received at the Agricultural Tent on Tuesday, August 22nd (the day before the fair opens) from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Exhibitor's name may not appear on the entry, only on the exhibitor card. Judging will begin immediately at 3:00 p.m.
3. **Included in this division are home canned foods, canned pickles and relishes.**
4. Each entry must be accompanied by the recipe, followed with processing method and time indicated. Tasting will be subject to the judge's discretion.
5. Two entries must be entered of the same product. All jars must be labeled with the name of product and date canned. All canned foods must be processed according to USDA recommendations or will be disqualified. One jar will be opened (smaller size is acceptable for opening) and the other will be used for display. Scoring for all classes will be calculated on clean, standard size containers.
6. Products must be properly sealed and screw bands rust free and have been processed within the last 12 months. The package should be full and attractive. Size, shape and quality should be uniform with a suitable proportion of liquid. Color is to be natural and uniform and texture appropriate. Flavor will be estimated in case of low-acid foods.
7. The jar that was opened for judging may be picked up on Tuesday, August 22nd, after 8:00 p.m. in the agriculture tent.
8. **THE UNOPENED JAR MUST REMAIN FOR DISPLAY. NO ENTRY IS ALLOWED TO BE REMOVED PRIOR TO THE END OF THE FAIR.** After the exhibits are arranged, they will be under exclusive charge of the Fair Committee. Exhibits must be called for by the exhibitor Sunday, August 27th at 5:00 p.m. Those exhibit's still present after 5:30 p.m. will be forfeited by the owner, and disposed of.
9. Any entries unfit to show will be disqualified. The management may at any time remove an exhibit which is in bad condition.

10. A card containing the name and address of the exhibitor may be attached to the exhibit after it has been judged.

11. All classes are open to all exhibitors, but subject to above rules and regulations.
