## **HEIFERS CALVED BETWEEN**

1. Junior Heifer Calves January 1 and later
2. Winter Heifer Calves Nov. 1 and Dec. 31, 2016
3. Senior Heifer Calves Sept. 1 and Oct. 31, 2016
4. Late Summer Yearling Heifers July 1 and Aug. 31, 2016
5. Early Summer Yearling Heifers May 1 and June 30, 2016
6. Late Junior Yearling Heifers March 1 and April 30, 2016
7. Early Junior Yearling Heifers Jan.1 and Feb. 28, 2016
8. Senior Yearling Heifers Sept. 1 and Dec. 31, 2015

\* Champion Heifer Calf and First and Second Place animals  
Reserve Champion Heifer Calf of Classes 1, 2, and 3 compete

\* Junior Champion and Reserve First and Second Place animals  
Junior Champion Heifers of Classes 4, 5, and 6 compete

\* Senior Champion and Reserve First and Second Place animals  
Senior Champion Heifers of Classes 7 and 8 compete

\* Grand Champion and Reserve Calf, Junior & Senior  
Grand Champion Heifers Champions & Reserve compete

9. **COW/CALF** – Cow must be owned by exhibitor. All calves must be born in 2017. All cows and calves must be shown on halter. Winner of class is not eligible for Grand Champion Female. Class will be split by age of cows if necessary.

## **BULLS CALVED BETWEEN**

10. Junior Bull Calves January 1 and later
11. Winter Bull Calves Nov. 1 and Dec. 31, 2016
12. Senior Bull Calves Sept. 1 and Oct. 31, 2016
13. Late Summer Yearling Bulls July 1 and Aug. 31, 2016
14. Early Summer Yearling Bulls May 1 and June 30, 2016
15. Late Junior Yearling Bulls March 1 and Apr. 30, 2016
16. Early Junior Yearling Bulls Jan. 1 and Feb 28, 2016
17. Senior Yearling Bulls Sept. 1 and Dec. 31, 2015
18. Late Two-Year Old Bulls May 1 and Aug. 30, 2015
19. Early Two-Year Old Bulls Jan. 1 and Apr. 30, 2015

## GROUP CLASSES

20. **Get of Sire:** Four animals, both sexes represented. Sired by one bull, all owned by exhibitor. All animals to be shown in individual classes to be eligible.

21. **Calf Get of Sire:** Four Calves by one sire, both sexes to be represented. All owned by exhibitor. Eligible for Get of Sire. All Animals to be shown in individual classes to be eligible.

22. **Best Six Head:** Owned by exhibitor. All animals must be shown in individual classes to be eligible.

23. **Jersey Special:** Best two head-must be show in individual classes and owned by the same individual.

24. **Premier Exhibitor:** Computed from winnings: 3 point first place, 2 points second place and 1 point third place. Three points for Grand Champion; two points for Reserve. No points for division champions and reserves. No points for group classes.

25. **Premier Breeder:** Computed from winnings of animals bred by exhibitor. Scoring the same as indicated for premiere exhibitor.

26. **Best New Breeder:** High point award for new breeder exhibiting for first time at the show.

## FOR JUNIORS ONLY

\* Juniors will exhibit their bulls and heifers in the Open show this year. Exception will be the Junior Steer class and Junior Showmanship classes.

\* Steer Show: Any Junior Member with a steer. Write "Junior Steer" as class number on the entry form.

\* Bred and Owned Heifer: Junior members who have bred their own heifers compete.

\* Junior Showmanship: Any Junior Member may compete. There is no fee for this class. Divisions will be broken down by age and indicated in the show program.

\* **Don Kniffen Memorial Showmanship:** Any Junior member who has not previously won this class.

## OPEN STEER DIVISION

Classes will be divided into Heavyweight, Middleweight, and Lightweight divisions after the animals are weighed in the morning of the show. Steers must weigh a minimum of 900 pounds.

First and Second place animals from each weight class will make up the championship class.

Write "Steer" as class number for all steer entries on the entry form.
