GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

Management

- 1. All exhibits shall be under the directions and control of the Hunterdon County 4-H and Agricultural Fair Association. The Association, under the circumstances, will not be responsible for any loss, injury, or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal or article on exhibition, and the exhibitor shall indemnity the Association and management thereof against all claims or account of or resulting from the exhibitor's negligent handling of his exhibit.
- 2. Any exhibitor or his representative or agent who violates any of these Rules and Regulations of the Hunterdon County 4-H and Agricultural Fair will forfeit all privileges and premiums, and may be barred from future shows.

Exhibitors

- 3. Exhibitors participating in activities at the Hunterdon County 4-H and Agricultural Fair are responsible to the superintendents of the departments.
- 4. Exhibitors are responsible for the care of exhibits, equipment and facilities. Superintendents reserve the privilege of ruling on such cases.

Health Requirements

5. **NEW - The Hunterdon County 4-H & Agricultural Fair will be following the recommendation of the NJ Department of Agriculture:

**A mammalians including goat, sheep, horse, cattle, alpaca, swine and llama which will be exhibited at the Hunterdon County 4-H & Agricultural Fair must be vaccinated for rabies. The vaccination must be recorded on your CVI by the veterinarian. Any livestock who is not vaccinated will not be allowed on grounds. A copy of the CVI must be handed into the show superintendent on the day of the show and then put on file at the fair office.

Entries

- 6. Entries must be made on printed entry furnished by the New Jersey Polled Hereford Association, unless approved by the manager and must be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations governing the show.
- 7. All information and signatures asked for on the entry form MUST be furnished. Entries will not be accepted unless this information is provided. Exhibitors must have registration certificates available at any time during the show. Photocopies of registration certificates will not be accepted.
- 8. The number of classes and class designation will be determined at the Superintendent's discretion.
- 9. Entry Fees **MUST** accompany entries and will not be refunded.
- 10. ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, AUGUST 17, 2018. Entry fees are \$10/head and no further entry fees will be required for group glasses. Late entries will be accepted up until the day of the show at \$15/head.
