RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Please see our website, nwba.njbeekeepers.org for further information.
2. Entries may not be removed from Fairground’s display before last day of fair.
3. Honey must be produced by a **PAID** member of the NJ Beekeepers Association.
4. There may be only one entry per class from any one membership.
5. Mead products must contain honey produced by entrant.
6. No labels on any entry. This rule applies to all classes.
7. Honey entries will be judged on the following basis:

Analytical Moisture Content (%)

15 to 17%	20 points
17.1 to 18.0	18 points
18.1 to 18.6	15 points
> 18.6	0 points

Quality

Absence of Defects, e.g.: wax, lint, foam, etc.	20 points
Flavor	10 points
Aroma	10 points
Clarity: free of suspended particles like pollen or other suspended solids. Air bubbles	20 points
Container appearance & cleanliness	10 points
Container Uniform Fill	10 points

Total Points100 points

8. Multiple entries for 4-H Bee Clubs will be allowed, but require one supervising, paid NJBA member to sponsor the entry. There is to be one entry per class per individual.

CLASSES:

1. 3 one pound extracted – light
2. 3 one pound extracted – light amber
3. 3 one pound extracted – amber
4. 3 one pound extracted – dark
5. Section honey and cut comb
6. Creamed honey, 3 one pound jars
7. Chunk honey, 3 one pound jars
8. One frame of honey
9. Mead – dry
10. Mead – sweet
11. Mead – made with fruit juices
12. Mead – sparkling, with or without fruit juice
13. Beeswax block – 1 pound
14. Novelty beeswax – any size, any shape
15. Beeswax tapers – one pair or dipped tapered
16. Novelty beeswax candles – any size, shape. May be decorated and/or painted
17. Hand cream/Lotion
18. Soap
19. Lip Balm
20. Photography

AWARDS:

1st place - \$12 and ribbon

2nd place - \$10 and ribbon

3rd place - \$8 and ribbon

Best Exhibitor - \$15

Best of Show - \$15

Best of show will be awarded to the person, who in the opinion of the judge, has the single first place entry that represents the division and class entered better than any other first place entry.
