New to the fair this year, is the Farm to Table Auction. The auction will showcase animals, eggs, vegetables, anything farm related for the table. We want to highlight as many of our 4-H members and projects.

1. Register for the auction at [www.4hfresh.org](http://www.4hfresh.org) .
2. Animals/items will be categorized as live auction and silent auction. This will be determined by the auction committee.
3. Participants will need to find a buyer for live animals.
4. Registrations will close on August 1, 2018.
5. Participants need to be registered 4-H members who are in good club standing.
6. All projects must be, owned by and raised by the 4-H member as of May 1, 2017.
7. All livestock/items must be graded prior to the auction. If there is no county show offered to you for this, you can have your items graded prior to the auction. Grading will be available when you bring your items to the goat barn.
8. Only animals/items of an excellent rating will qualify for the auction
9. All items other than livestock must be delivered to the goat barn on Saturday, August 26th, between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.
10. Livestock must be brought to the goat barn between 4:00 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. There will be pens available for your livestock as well as tables for your table items.
11. You may enter any project as long as it fits within the “Farm to Table” idea.
12. Each participant can register in two of the following categories
  - a. One or two livestock animals including (goat, sheep, veal calf, alpaca, dairy-beef, beef)
  - b. One or two lots of two meat rabbits in each lot
  - c. Two lots of 3 or less chickens (market or egg layer)
  - d. One lot of 5-6 chickens (market or egg layers)
  - e. One dozen eggs
  - f. Lot 3 dozen eggs
  - g. Two large size fruit/vegetable baskets of produce
  - h. Two farm related art/craft pieces (ie: table cloth, centerpiece, napkins/rings, candles, etc)
  - i. Two farm related photos, matted and framed any size
  - j. Lot of 5 bales of hay/straw (any variety)
13. You must submit a short explanation explaining what you are auctioning off.
14. All 4-H members who are participating in the auction must be available for auction set up and clean up, 4:00 p. to 7:00 p.m.
