

Hunterdon County 4-H & Agricultural Fair Overnight Herdsmen Agreement

Being herdsman is a privilege and a responsibility; your behavior should reflect this. You represent 4-H to the public. Herdsmen are expected to do the job as outlined in the Hunterdon County 4-H & Agricultural Fair Herdsmen Job Description, follow the rules and to respect the authority of the 4-H agent, 4-H program assistant, leader, parent and any other appointed authority.

I will fulfill my duties as an exhibitor and overnight herdsman

_____ I will plan stay overnight at the fair for the care of the animals in my barn.

_____ I understand that my shift as overnight herdsman is from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM

_____ I understand that I will take responsibility for my own animals throughout the day.

_____ I understand that being an overnight herdsman, does not mean that I do not have to help in the barn/tent throughout the day.

_____ I will abide by the code of conduct and rules of the fair.

NO, DRUGS, NO ALCOHOL: Any 4-H'er under the influence of or in possession of drugs, alcohol, or any other intoxicating substance will be immediately sent home and suspended for the remainder of the activity and future 4-H participation may be restricted or prohibited.

NO SMOKING: Smoking is prohibited at all 4-H events and activities.

DISPLAYING OF AFFECTION: Exhibit dignified and restrained actions in expressing affection.

LANGUAGE: Language must be controlled and appropriate for a 4-H member. Foul or abusive language is not appropriate.

GENERAL CONDUCT: Respect the individuality of all persons. Treat others with dignity and kindness. Consider their needs as well as your own. Be a good steward of the environment and all living things. Treat all forms of life with respect and care.

DRESS CODE: 4-H has very strict dress code policy, and you are expected to uphold that policy. Be sure to wear proper attire, no drug or alcohol related shirts, shorts should be of arm length, two finger rule on shirts, no cami tops or tube tops. Shoes that protect your feet are required (no flip flops, crocks, sandals).
